Subscription Variances

Full subscriptions must be paid by or soon after 01 July each year. Reminders will be issued but failure to pay correct subscription within 6 months of the due date will result in erasure from the membership and loss of privileges, including use of post nominals. (See note below about re-joining)

Reduced subscription rates

These are available after completion of an application and a signed declaration. These reductions do not apply to Student Affiliate rates.

The following percentage reductions have been agreed

Maternity / Paternity /Adoption 50%
(Only one reduced subscription per pregnancy / adoption greater than six months leave)

Long Term sickness associated with inability / reduced ability to work 50%

Low total income (earned and unearned) from all sources (less than £38,000/annum gross) 50%

Working wholly outside forensic medicine 50%

Career Break 50%
(Max 2 years - then transfer to Retired)

Re-joining Conditions

When considering applications to re-join the Faculty following involuntary erasure for non-payment of correct subscription the erasure will be considered to apply from the July 1st that the subscription became due and not the date on which the Faculty actually erased the membership.

A member wishing to re-join the Faculty having left the membership of the Faculty for less than 1 year either voluntarily or involuntarily (as a result of failure to pay correct subscription or for any other reason) may do so by payment of £50.00 administration fee and also the outstanding pro-rata subscription for that year.

A member wishing to re-join the Faculty having left the membership of the Faculty for more than 1 year either voluntarily or involuntarily (as a result of failure to pay correct subscription or for any other reason) must submit a new application and, if approved by the Membership and Fellowship

Committee (MFC), must pay the current full registration fee and also the outstanding pro-rata subscription.

Foundation Members / Fellows

Different rules apply as this Membership / Fellowship was granted under special terms and conditions and during limited time frames all of which (apart for DLA applicants) have now expired and are no longer available.

A Foundation Member or Fellow who resigns from the Faculty or who is erased for non-payment of correct subscription or for any other reason must apply to sit the relevant Membership examination or apply for membership in the Affiliate category.
