Poster Presentation FAQs

How long should my abstract be? The abstract should be no more than 250 words.

How do I submit my abstract?

Email your abstract (using the <u>abstract submission form</u>) to <u>forensic.medicine@fflm.ac.uk</u> with the subject reference 'your name – Annual Conference 2020 poster' by: Sunday 29 March 2020 (for students) and; Friday 07 February 2020 (for fully qualified attendees).

What size/orientation should my poster be?

All posters must be in portrait layout, preferably A0 size (841mm wide by 1189mm high). Handouts and/or reduced photocopies of your poster for distribution to interested delegates are always appreciated.

When and where will my poster be viewed?

All posters will be displayed in the refreshments area on Saturday 16 May 2020. We suggest your poster is up by the end of the registration period. Authors are required to be present next to their posters during refreshment/lunch breaks.

What should I do if I am unable to present my poster myself?

If you cannot attend you will not be able to present your poster at the conference. However, you will be able to send a colleague in your place, but you must inform us by contacting <u>forensic.medicine@fflm.ac.uk</u>. Please note that your replacement presenter cannot be already presenting a poster of their own.

What do I do with my poster after the conference?

If you would like to retrieve your poster after the conference, you should remove it from display by the close of the conference on Saturday 16 May 2020. Any posters not collected will be recycled.
