FORM OF FAITH

Fellows, Members, Licentiates, Affiliates and Associates are expected to act in accordance with the Standing Orders and, in a wider sense, have a duty not to compromise the name of the Faculty and to conduct themselves in a way which does not compromise their professional standing or registration or other authority to practise medicine.

In electing you the Faculty must satisfy itself that you are of such good standing and, by agreeing the following Form of Faith, you are endorsing this view. Therefore, should you be aware of any circumstances which you feel may contradict this, and which might cause difficulty for you or the Faculty subsequently (such as being the subject of a GMC inquiry or a pending criminal prosecution), you are invited to declare them to the Registrar. This will be treated in confidence and any such details will be considered on their own merits.

I hereby faithfully promise to abide by the Standing Orders of the Faculty of Forensic & Legal Medicine and the relevant Bye-Laws, Statutes and Regulations of the Royal College of Physicians of London as they apply to Fellows, Members Licentiates, Affiliates and Associates of the Faculty of Forensic & Legal Medicine.
